Action needed - Your plans for September 2022 and KentChoices

In November we wrote to your parent(s) or carer(s) about the KentChoices website and how you could use it to help you make decisions about what to do after Year 11, then apply to Kent sixth forms and colleges through it.

Since then, your school will have spoken to you about your options and should also have introduced you to KentChoices.

What do I need to do now?

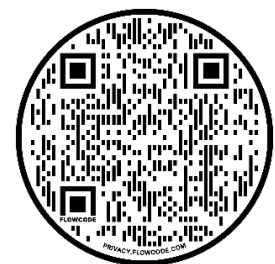
I am now writing directly to you, to let you know it is time to start confirming your plans and to make sure that you have a backup plan in case you do not get the GCSE grades expected.

If you applied to a sixth form or college through KentChoices you now need to log on and put any offers you have received in order of preference by 30th April. This is to help schools and colleges get ready for September. There is a forgotten username/password function if you need it.

If you did not use KentChoices to apply for sixth form or college, have been offered a place and you have accepted it, then no further action is needed, unless you applied to an EKC Group College. See below.

EKC Group Colleges (Ashford, Broadstairs, Canterbury, Dover, Folkestone, Sheppey and EKC Sixth Form College)

If you have received any offers of a place at one of the EKC Group Colleges, you will receive an email asking you to go on to their EKC Group Application Portal (<https://apply.eastkent.ac.uk/login>) to confirm you want it. If you have more than one offer, you will again, need to put them in order of preference.

Remember - if you have applied to one of these colleges and have not yet booked your interview, make sure to log on to their portal and do this as soon as you can.

If I have an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP)?

You don't need to log on to KentChoices to put any offers in order of preference unless your school specifically asks you to. If you do not know what you are doing in September yet, ask at your school for an update.

Staying in touch

Kent County Council is required to stay in touch with you for two years after Year 11 and provide free support and advice. To do this, we (The Education People) will make contact with you at regular intervals. 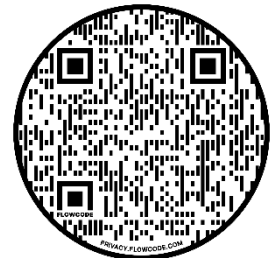
